

## **Block Party Agenda**

1. Gathering – 15 minutes
  - a. Badges at the Door
    - i. Name, City, Neighborhood
  - b. Signup sheets at each table
    - i. Name, Email, Phone
2. Food and Introductions – 30 minutes
  - a. Welcome prayer and call to begin eating
  - b. Introduce the concept of each table representing a single neighborhood
  - c. Description of purpose
    - i. Create a forum and event that you can take with you and repeat within your own neighborhood or organization
  - d. Play the Phoenix simulation – requires internet access
3. Treasure Hunt – 15 minutes
  - a. Ask each table to brainstorm for items they would use in a disaster
  - b. Use this to have them begin filling out the inventory list for their neighborhood
  - c. Call out 10 items – Table with the most gets a door prize
4. Special Needs – 15 minutes
  - a. Use the special needs descriptions to give each neighborhood a test case to discuss
  - b. Allow teams to brainstorm on how to handle various types of special needs
  - c. Ask each table about their special needs case and how they would take action
5. Create a Task List and Plan – 45 minutes
  - a. Start with each table listing out the various tasks that they can think of – 5 min
  - b. Ask each table to list out what they came up with and build a comprehensive list – 5 min
  - c. Provide a timing example for 'Debris' – 5 min
    - i. Explain D-2, D-1...
    - ii. D-2: Neighborhood walk through – tree and fence maintenance
    - iii. D-1: Walk through for current state
    - iv. D: Party
    - v. D+1: Assess damage and provide short term relief where possible
    - vi. D+2: Long term damage repair, insurance work...
  - d. Ask each table to work out the timing for their list – 15 minutes
  - e. Ask each team to work out assignments for their list – 15 minutes
6. Review examples from each table and discuss – 15 minutes
7. Provide some other checklist examples – 15 minutes
8. Q&A – 15 minutes
9. Call to Action – 5 minutes
  - a. Take this back to your neighborhood/association/organization
  - b. Work on building out your plan
    - i. Talk about additional training (CERT, Red Cross...)
